Rekids welcome Mr G...

With three amazing releases so far, all different and all of a very high standard, Matt **Radio Slave**, who has been a name to check ever since his first bootleg mix, is now really starting to shine as A&R of what is already a very exciting label. So far he's drawn on the production talents of Roman Flugel, Jesse Rose, Toby Tobias and Prins Thomas and now he presents **Mr G**.

For anyone affiliated or interested in techno, **Colin McBean** aka Mr G should be a very familiar name. In 1989 he was part of the **KCC** DJ trio playing at the now legendary **Confusion** parties and a year later started recording as one half of **The Advent** with Cisco Ferreira, producing many ground-breaking releases/remixes and touring the world over with their own intense, relentless style of techno. After going their separate ways in 1999, Colin founded his label **Phoenix G** that he uses as an output to release his own brand of analogue driven, bass-heavy electronic tech-funk. An acute ear for high quality, a deep musical knowledge and masterful skills behind the mixing desk has led to ultimate respect from his peers and the press.

It should be no surprise to anyone that '**E.C.G'ed**' is a brilliant piece of stripped down, rolling Detroit-influenced deep techno. Sounding like a lost and found Carl Craig classic, this is serious stuff. **Acid undertones** supply the backbone to this **brooding groove**, followed closely by layers of sharp percussion and instantly recognisable analogue effects. Coupled with the huge **disco horn section**, that is just desperate to be apart of what's going on up front make this subtle but dark beast in to somewhat of an epic!

It would only be right for Matt to get in on the action and his remix under his **Rekid** alias is an exceptional alternative to what is already a class A-side. Just as deep as you'd expect, although adding a bit more bounce and jack into the mix, to the untrained ear it may seem like not much is happening, but hear this in a crowded Room 1 at Fabric and you can be assured to be overtaken by this **hypnotic floor-filler**.
