To most it was no surprise that the label setup by the exceptionally talented Matt 'Radio Slave' Edwards succeeded but it's not always an easy task to put into practice and the status of Rekids has been down to one vital component – brilliant music.

Toby's first release for the label last June was an early sign of things to come... 'A Close Shave' was a big melting pot of ideas; fusing Disco, Italo, House, Shuffling Techno and Funk that was accompanied by a Prins Thomas remix straight out of the top drawer.

'Dave's Sex Bits' doesn't disappoint, Toby has stepped up and delivered another killer record. Once again drawing on a number of influences and styles to create a deep, meandering but still upfront and totally danceable piece of music. It's filled with funk and is without doubt a tip of the cap to late 70's/early 80's experimental electronic disco that he's such a fan of.

Quiet Village, like Mr Tobias, are connoisseurs of the experimental side of electronic music and are well known for their deep, rolling, spacey grooves that are loved the world over. They deliver just that, a mind-blowing 10-minute journey into deep space! Big.

To round up, it's been an amazing first year of music for Rekids, with thanks to Roman Flugel, Toby Tobias, Prins Thomas, Jesse Rose, Mr G, Ripperton, Spencer Parker, Luke Solomon, Claude VonStroke and Matt O'Brien for all their productions. With plenty more hot releases already lined up for 2007 and the first Rekids compilation coming soon featuring exclusive tracks and remixes, we hope the second year is just as enjoyable as the first!
