Rekids have started 2007 in the same way they started '06 - with a bang! The first release of the New Year was the wonderful 'Dave's Sex Bits' by Toby Tobias, which has and still is receiving some fantastic support. Next up is 'Miscalate'...

Audiofly, aka Luca Saporito and Anthony Middleton are the current darlings of London and Ibiza, since embarking on a prolific partnership in Spring 2002 the pair have forged quite a reputation for themselves. Not only holding down residencies at some of the best clubs in London and Ibiza (The End/Space) but on the production side they've had the opportunity to work with some of the hottest labels and artists in the scene. Expect their profile and discography to keep growing and growing...

Paul Harris needs little introduction, a man who's been DJing and producing in the Dance music scene from the early 90's. An early cohort of Nicky Holloway, Paul Oakenfield and Pete Tong, a Grammy award winner with Dirty Vegas and a DJ to the stars – he's been there and seen it all. Speaking about the coming together with Anthony and Luca, "It all happened after Audiofly remixed my track on Saved. I was impressed at what they did in the studio and mentioned a collaboration. We spent two long days holed up in Audiofly HQ in Hoxton and 'Miscalate' was the result. It was great working with them, although Luca's a little crazy, he likes to do a funny dance whilst working!"

'Miscalate' starts off as a smooth, deep house record but quickly chooses a darker path and a big rumbling bassline takes over with sharp electronics following closely behind. As with all the production work of Audiofly and Paul Harris, it's the interesting structure and musical side of the track that really makes it stand out. Subtle female vocal samples and layers of filters and effects really elevate it into a big tune for the coming months.

Partial Arts, a new project from Ewan Pearson and Al Usher, take control and not just remix but remake the track! They've delivered something rather special. A very unique, different and exciting production that will surely be turning heads and pricking the ears of many – Partial Arts are a name to watch this year.
